
B Branch Weekend Access

Track & Intersection Upgrades




Monday, August 31, 2020 | Weekend 1 Roll-Up

Saturday 12:00 AM – Monday 3:00 AM | This weekend, from early Saturday morning to Monday morning, we have replaced 1,000 feet of track between **Washington Street** and **Warren Street Stations** on the Green Line B Branch. This is the first of four weekends of work from August 29 through September 27 (skipping Labor Day). Boston College to Babcock was out of service



Safety Counts

- Use appropriate face protection when performing **rail grinding**





Between Summit Avenue and Washington Street, crews worked on track demolition [Picture | 1]. Rail, ties and ballast were successfully removed. The sub base was compacted and new ties were installed [Picture | 2]

Between Melvin Avenue and Washington Street, crews performed thermite welding, grinding the welds down to provide a smooth ride for Green Line passengers [Picture | 3] and ultrasonic testing [Picture | 4]

Alternative Service | Shuttle Bus Service

Shuttle bus service was provided from Boston College to Babcock Station, at new stops to improve accessibility.
