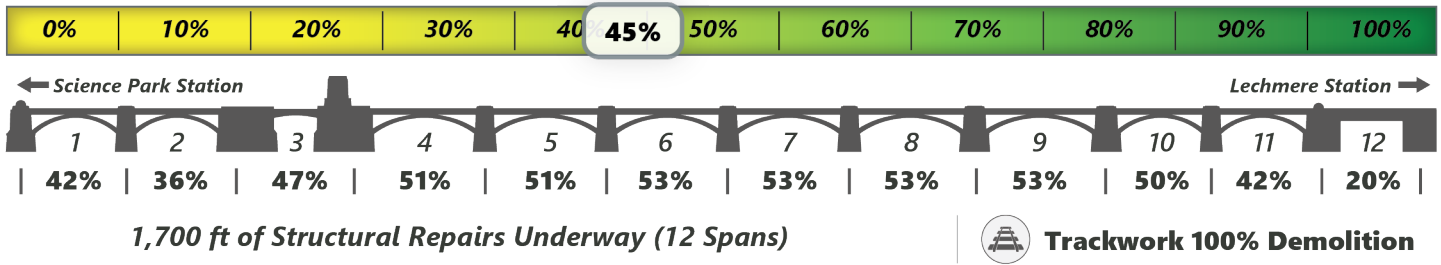
Week in Review | Spotlight on Green Line Operations

Lechmere Viaduct Rehabilitation



Strengthen and preserve the 110-year-old viaduct for heavier loads and increased train frequency

- ✓ **Last Week** | Crack injections and concrete repairs continued, as well as steel repairs on bascule span 3. These improvements will strengthen the bridge without sacrificing the historic façade of the structure

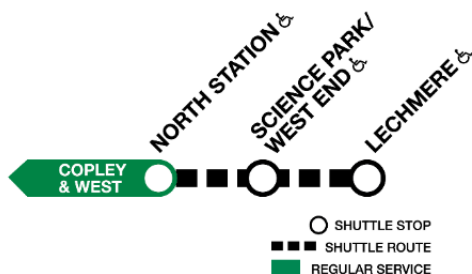
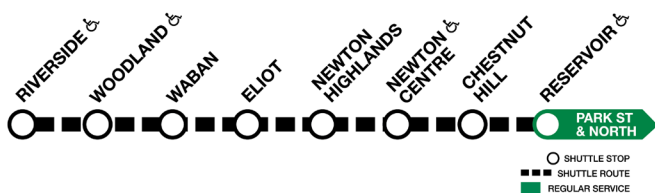
