

Local 264 Bus Maintenance Improvement Agreement

Side Letter of Agreement – State of Good Repair – Feb. 5, 2018

In the course of negotiations for a successor agreement to the 2014 – 2018 Agreement the Parties acknowledged a shared interest in improving the state of good repair in the Authority's bus garages. In keeping with that shared interest the Authority has confirmed its intention to commit a minimum of \$25 million annually to maintain/upgrade/improve the state of repair in the Authority's garages. This commitment extends for four fiscal years, to commence in Fiscal Year 2019. The Authority will review outcomes from this commitment with the Union on an annual basis.

Local 264 Priority Needs List

Lighting: Poor lighting in shops, fuel alley, bus storage and bus yards.

Ventilation: Inoperable exhaust fans and exhaust hoses in shops.

Shop Floors: Floors are Uneven.

Bus Yards: Ruts, holes, pot holes in bus yards.

Steel Plates: Unsafe plates used to cover up damaged floors in shops and Busways.

Rodent/Pigeon Infestation: health risks to all employees.

Heating/Cooling: Inefficient heat and air conditioning needs to be repaired and maintained.

Fluid/Air Hose Reels: Prevent tripping hazards, leaking equipment and cleaner work area.

Shop Tools: Perform jobs safety/efficiently (working lifts, jacks, tire dollies, doors, diagnostic tools).

Drainage: Issues in shops and in bus yards.

Pits: Quincy and Lynn garages are in need of immediate repair.

Doors: Standardize for maintenance efficiency.





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



New Quincy Facility
