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Project Overview

- Today's board action will provide urgent replacement of thirteen (13) existing facility roofs in Boston, Brookline, Malden, Medford, Quincy and Watertown, Massachusetts. This contract will also allow, on an on-call basis, the ability to respond to emergencies and/or urgently needed roof repairs. These locations include:

 - 3. Cabot Motormen's Lobby
 - 4. Cabot Trackworkers' Lobby

 - 9. JFK/UMass Station
 - 10. Malden Station Unit Substation
 - 11. Sullivan Square Station
 - 12. Charlestown Engineering & Maintenance Building # 2
 - 13. 45 High Street

VOTED:


