Program Overview & Objectives

Overview:

- The need for elevator replacements and renovations for 9 stations throughout the area to make the stations fully accessible
- Construction will be phased to ensure stations remain accessible throughout the project
- These projects are in various stages of design and/or funding approval
 - Design Contracts awarded: Summer 2020
 - > Total Design Contracts Value: \$34 million
 - > Status: 30% Design Complete, progressing to 75%


Objectives:

- Improve station accessibility with more reliable elevator service, as well as improvements to pedestrian circulation, station lighting and wayfinding
- Improved safety, reliability, and customer experience


Scope & Locations

Elevators Under Design:

- Mass Ave: 1 new unit and 1 replacement
- Jackson Square: 1 new unit and 1 replacement
- Arlington Street: 3 new units
- North Station: 2 new units
- Sullivan: 1 new unit and 2 replacements
- **Davis:** 2 new units and 2 replacements
- **Broadway:** 2 new units and 2 replacements
- **Chinatown:** 2 new units and 2 replacements
- State Street: 1 new unit and 2 replacements




Mass Ave. Station




- Designer: AECOM
- Install one (1) new elevator for redundancy
- Replace one (1) existing elevator
- New entrance over the Orange Line Tracks
- Station stair improvements
- Mass Ave entrance door upgrades

Jackson Square Station



- Designer: AECOM
- Install one (1) new elevator for redundancy
- Replace one (1) existing elevator
- Station stair improvements at North and South stairs
- Exterior sidewalk and bus berth upgrades

Arlington Station




- Designer: STV
- Install two (2) new elevators at Berkeley end of the platform and one (1) new elevator leading from the Berkeley Street entrance to the street
- Install ADA compliant fare collection gates
- Reopening of Berkley Street entrance

North Station



- Designer: STV
- Install two (2) new elevators leading from the entrance lobby to the Inbound and Outbound platforms
- Install a pedestrian bridge connecting the entrance lobby and outbound platform





- Install one (1) new pass-through elevator connecting the lower bus loop with the orange line station entrance
- Replace the two (2) existing elevators and convert those to pass through style elevators




Davis Square Station

- Replace one (1) elevator at College Avenue Headhouse
- Install one (1) elevator to the Holland Street Headhouse providing redundancy
- Replace one (1) existing elevator connecting mezzanine to platform
- Install one (1) elevator connecting mezzanine to the platform providing redundancy



- Install two (2) new elevators at the southbound and northbound platforms
- New station entrances at Hayward Place and LaGrange Street
- Replace the two (2) existing elevators
- Rebuild existing lobby floors and stairs to meet accessibility requirements

- Replace the two (2) existing elevators at station
