
## Orange Line Transformation Construction Project Updates

## Week in Review and Lookahead Friday, March 4, 2022

Work continues on the **Orange Line Transformation** (OLT) **Program's** active construction projects, including Wellington Yard and Maintenance Facility, and the Traction Power Substations. Read more about project progress below





<u>Traction Power Substations:</u> Modernize the third rail power supply to reduce the risk of service disruptions; develop a power system capable of supporting additional Orange Line service

- ✓ This Week | Began point to point testing of power system infrastructure
- Lookahead | Continue point to point testing. Investigate communications cable connection at Sullivan Square



<u>Wellington Yard:</u> Upgrade Wellington Yard to increase service capacity, replace outdated infrastructure, and enhance safety.

- ✓ This Week | Completed storage tracks 31 and 32. Began work on Tracks 36-38 for track adjustments
- **Lookahead |** Begin signal testing and the installation of duct bank in the North Yard. Continue track adjustments for tracks 36 and 38



<u>Wellington Maintenance Facility:</u> Modernize the Vehicle Maintenance Facility to improve vehicle maintenance; reducing customer wait times, provide cleaner cars, and deliver safer operations.

- This Week | Continued reconstruction of track structure of building tracks including car wash track 20 to accommodate new Orange Line vehicles. Also worked on fire alarms and architectural finishes
- **Lookahead** | Continue reconstruction of track 20 and painting of barrier wall of track 14 (Zone 6). Begin installation and testing of fire alarms in Tracks 12 and 13
