



Wellington Yard: Upgrade Wellington Yard to increase service capacity, replace outdated infrastructure, and enhance safety.

- **This Week |** Continued track and traction power infrastructure installation and signal testing at the Central Instrument House (CIH) in the North Yard. Completed installation of new wayside DC power switch and completed construction of a ductbank in the North Yard
- **Lookahead** | Continue signal testing and finalize the track adjustments on tracks 36, 37, and 38



Wellington Maintenance Facility: Modernize the Vehicle Maintenance Facility to improve vehicle maintenance; reducing customer wait times, provide cleaner cars, and deliver safer operations.

- ✓ This Week | Continued reconstruction of track 20, installed new rail and track infrastructure, and demolished lighting and conduits in maintenance pit tracks 16 and 17
