


Signal Upgrade: Increasing capacity, through reducing headways with modernized signals.

- This Week | Performed monitoring at Alewife and Davis after a successful cutover last weekend. Testing continued at Harvard, and signal components were installed at Porter, Central and Park St. Factory Acceptance Testing of equipment for Park St and Downtown Crossing was conducted offsite
