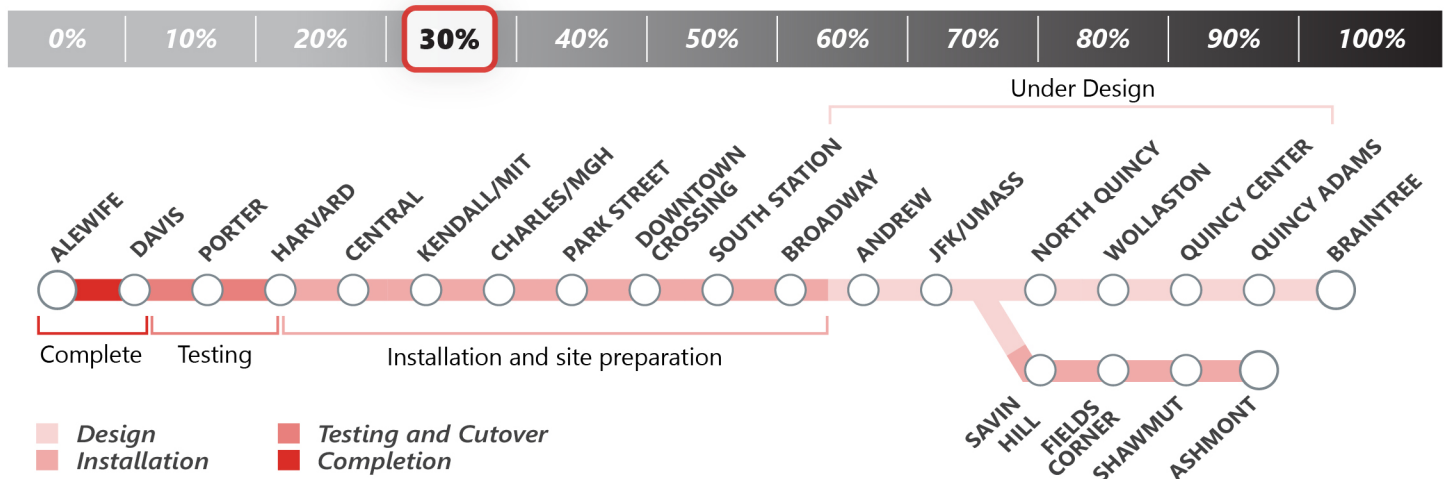
## Week in Review and Lookahead

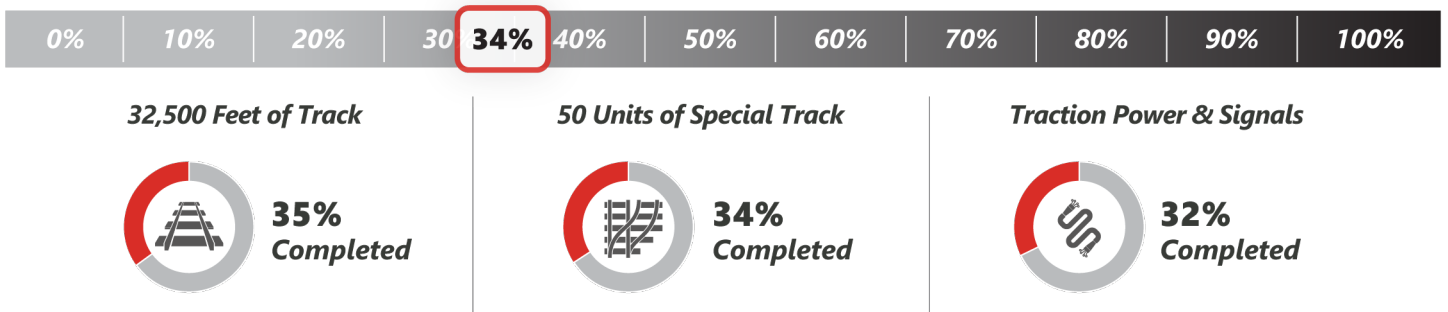
### Signal Upgrade



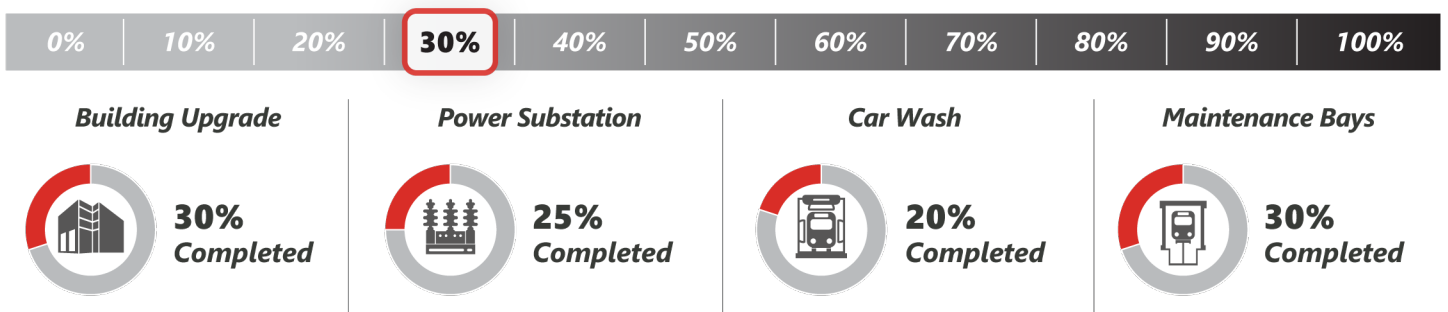
**Signal Upgrade:** Increasing capacity, through reducing headways with modernized signals.
