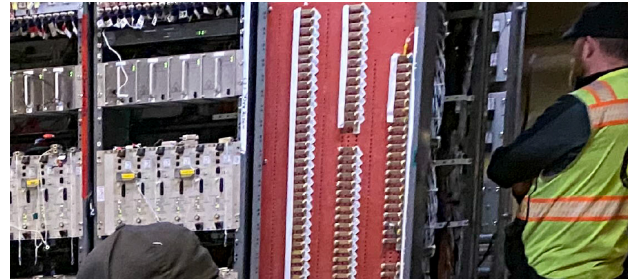

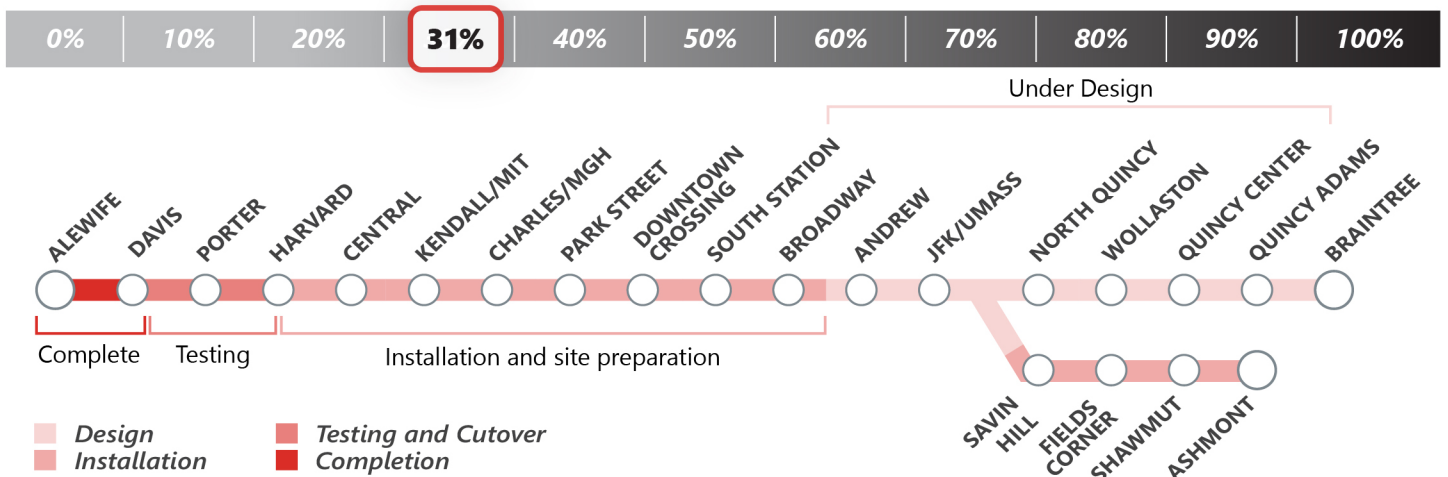

As April comes to a close, we continue to make progress on upgrades to the Red Line Signals! Continue reading to learn more about Red Line Transformation (RLT) Program work



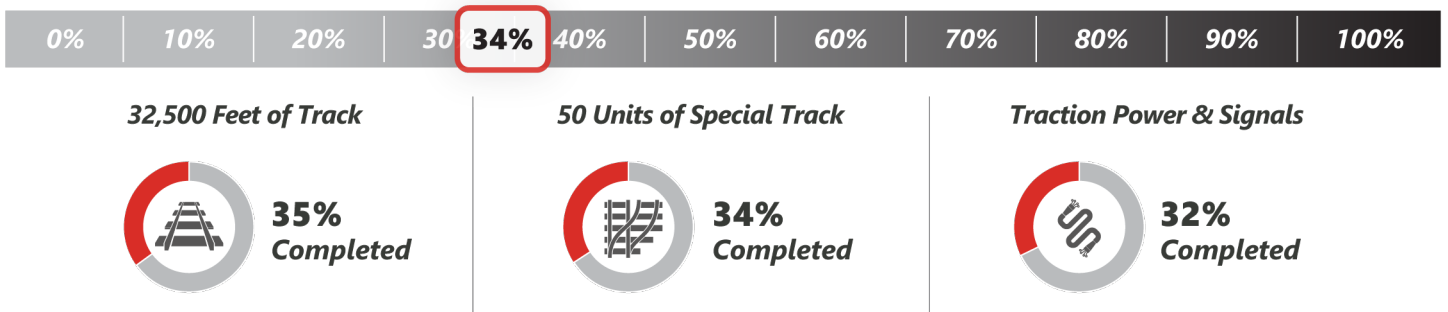
Signal Upgrade



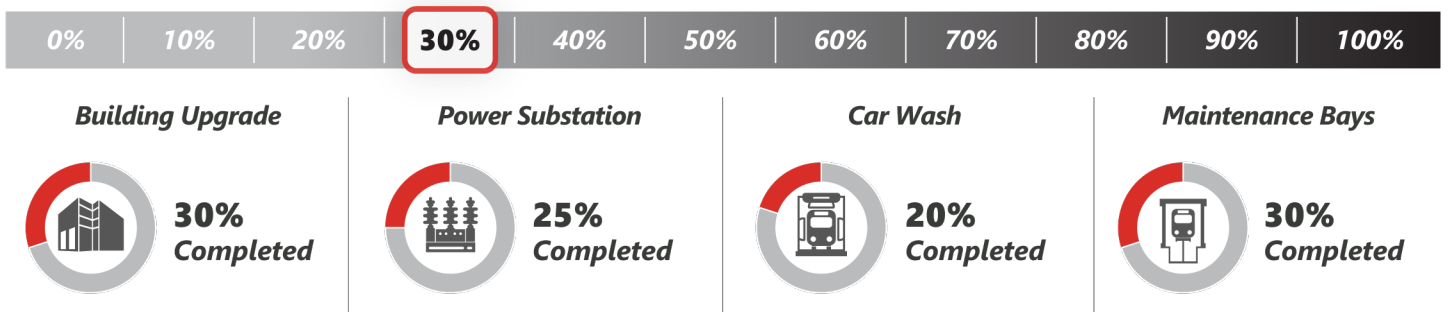
Signal Upgrade: Increasing capacity, through reducing headways with modernized signals.

- ✓ **This Week** | Crews installed signal infrastructure in the right-of-way near Ashmont as preparation for a new signal building. Meanwhile, installation of signal components continued at Park St and Downtown Crossing
- **Lookahead** | Continue testing at Harvard and Porter, and installation at Park St and Downtown Crossing. Infrastructure installation at Ashmont will continue during daytime hours
