


## Week in Review and Lookahead Friday, April 8, 2022

<u>Signal Upgrade:</u> Increasing capacity, through reducing headways with modernized signals.

- ✓ This Week | Testing continued at Harvard, and signal components were installed at Porter, Central and Park St. Factory Acceptance Testing of equipment for Park St and Downtown Crossing was conducted remotely. Commenced signal infrastructure installation at Ashmont
- Lookahead | Testing, installation, and manufacturing will continue from Porter Downtown Crossing and infrastructure installation at Ashmont
