


B Branch: Alternative Service from Boston College to Kenmore
 Monday, June 20 – Friday, July 1, 2022



During this 12-day period, we will install components of the Train Protection kits and attach speed sensors to the track, replace 3,200 feet of track, upgrade Linden St intersection and Fordham Rd pedestrian crossing, and replace special trackwork at Cardinal & Washington St Crossovers



Prep work will take place from June 6 – 10, however this will not affect Green Line service. During this time Commonwealth Ave between Brighton Ave and St Lukes Rd will be closed to non-emergency vehicle traffic. Drivers traveling from Brighton Ave to Commonwealth Ave will be able to detour on St Lukes Rd and turn right onto Commonwealth Ave



Shuttles do not stop at Warren St, Allston St, or Packards Corner Stations.
 Riders should use Washington St, Harvard Ave, and Babcock St stations as alternatives

Alternative Service: From June 20 – July 1 free shuttle buses will operate along the Green Line on the same schedule as train service.

- Shuttles are a combination of MBTA buses and private carrier buses
- All drivers are trained to assist riders and to operate lifts
- Service will be monitored throughout and adjusted to reduce crowding

Near Washington St: June 20 – July 1 – Commonwealth Ave will be reduced to one travel lane in each direction between Washington St and Summit Ave. There are no planned pedestrian or parking impacts.



Near Boston College: June 20 – July 1 – Commonwealth Ave will be reduced to one travel lane in each direction between Lake St and Greycliff Rd. There are no planned pedestrian impacts. Resident parking on Commonwealth Ave eastbound will be taken to accommodate vehicles traveling eastbound.

Detour signage will be in place for vehicles and pedestrians as needed, and police officers will be located at key locations to ensure safety.
