


Signal Upgrade

- ✓ This Week | Test trains operated on Monday and Tuesday night, with signal engineers and project personnel in observance at Harvard and Porter. Installation continued at Park Street, Oak Grove, and Malden Stations
- **Lookahead** | Crews will continue to conduct testing ahead of the cutover weekend (late June), which will transition the tracks in the vicinity of Harvard and Porter to the new digital signals system
