


Week in Review and Lookahead Friday, August 5, 2022

Wellington Yard and Maintenance Facility Updates



Wellington Yard: Upgrade Wellington Yard to increase service capacity, replace outdated infrastructure, and enhance safety.

- ✓ This Week | Crews installed track and electrical utilities in the south yard. The contractor also performed signal testing for new tracks in the south yard. In preparation for upcoming work on the mainline tracks, crews pre-assembled track components and staged materials ready for installation
- Lookahead | Crews will continue preparing for upcoming work on the mainline tracks



<u>Wellington Maintenance Facility</u>: Modernize the Vehicle Maintenance Facility to improve vehicle maintenance; reducing customer wait times, provide cleaner cars, and deliver safer operations.

- ✓ This Week | Crews continued the installation and painting of the overhead steel walkway platform system and steel mesh safety fencing. The contractor continued installing new flooring in the electronics repair room
- Lookahead | Replacement of additional rail track within the facility. Crews will continue to install catwalk steel platform system
