Green Line Transformation Construction Project Updates

Week in Review and Lookahead Friday, October 21, 2022

From Saturday, October 22 – Friday, October 28, shuttle buses will replace service on the D Branch for the final Green Line full access closure of 2022. Workers will upgrade two pedestrian crossings and replace 2,000 feet of track at Eliot Station, while continuing installation of Green Line Train Protection System equipment. Other crews will be working throughout the D Branch to complete additional improvements to safety and reliability. While this is the final full access closure of the year, our crews will continue working to implement GLTPS equipment around the Green Line





<u>Green Line Train Protection and Track Upgrades:</u> From June through October, we'll complete over 10,000 feet of track upgrades on the B, C, D, and E branches alongside work on the <u>Green Line Train Protection System (GLTPS)</u>
