
Red Line Transformation Construction Project Updates

Signal Upgrades





Signal Upgrade: Increasing capacity, through reducing headways with modernized signals.

- This Week | Contractor continued the installation of new electrical racks and wiring at the existing and temporary Quincy Adams signal houses, and removed old legacy wires at Davis Square. Technicians continued testing signals at Downtown Crossing and Central. Software updates and field modifications continued at Park Street
- Lookahead | Technicians will continue testing signals and installing new electrical components at Downtown Crossing, Ashmont, Park Street, Central, Quincy Adams, and Porter


Cabot Yard and Maintenance Facility Updates
