

Station Design Contract awarded to Thornton Tomasetti


- Design Start: Summer 2021

Structures Feasibility Study Contract awarded to VHB


- Design Start: Summer 2022

- Upgrades to supporting bridges and structures




Existing Condition – Lynn Station





Current condition of platform



Proposed Improvements

- Replace two existing elevators with ADA compliant elevators
- Replace and upgrade existing stairs
- New center island platform and canopy
- Upgrades to security systems and electrical utilities
- Improve station lighting and wayfinding signage



New Design Updates

- Two emergency egress stairs
- Emergency egress ramp
- Conducted a study addressing anticipated impacts of climate change
- Feasibility Study to better understand the condition of the bridges under the station




Next Steps

- Early Demolition Activities at Lynn Station Began in October 2022
- Continue Station Design
- Complete Feasibility Study of Bridges
- Finalize Design & Install Temporary Platforms



Service Alternatives

- Shuttle busing between Lynn and Swampscott Station Zone 2 Fares accepted at Swampscott
- From the North: Swampscott Station to the 455
- From Boston: Blue Line at Wonderland Station to the 441, 442, or 455
- From Chelsea: 117 from Bellingham Square to Wonderland Station to the 441, 442, or 455
- 426 Express Service between Lynn Central Square and Haymarket


