


Week in Review and Lookahead Friday, December 2, 2022




Signal Upgrades

<u>Wellington Yard:</u> Upgrade Wellington Yard to increase service capacity, replace outdated infrastructure, and enhance safety.

- ✓ **This Week** | Crews are conducting final signal testing procedures required to perform cutover & commissioning activities at the North Yard for the new signal system
- **Lookahead** | Crews will continue to work on cutover activities, install lubricators & modifiers, punch list, and close out items




<u>Wellington Maintenance Facility:</u> Modernize the Vehicle Maintenance Facility to improve vehicle maintenance; reducing customer wait times, providing cleaner cars, and delivering safer operations.

- ✓ **This Week** | Crews performed demolition and sawcut of concrete aprons at tracks 11 and 12 in preparation for track realignment. Electrical work including fire alarm wiring continued and demolition of old conduit on the mezzanine started
- **Lookahead** | Crews will be working on concrete pouring and rebar of track 11 and continue working on punch list items such as demolition of old conduit, plate covers and fire proofing

<u>Traction Power Substations:</u> Modernize the third rail power supply to reduce the risk of service disruptions; develop a power system capable of supporting additional Orange Line service

- ✓ This Week | At Oak Grove crews prepared to seal cracks with epoxy injections
- Lookahead | Crew will be performing epoxy injections at floor cracks
