



Pandemic Impact - Ridership Trend




Bus Ridership Trend




- At 282K, Bus Ridership is about 27% lower than the same week in 2019.
- Ridership has been ~steady, last 3 months – with Thanksgiving week as the exception.

We've met with Municipalities to ensure that areas are cleared:

- bus stops
- paths of travel to bus stops
- routes from bus stops to buses
- same at RR crossings.

We're running drills to exercise our response to storms. We're running snow fighting equipment and simulating storm cleanup activity on recent overnights.

We are refining our snow vendor contracts.





THE POLAR EXPRESS COMES TO LIFE: SOUTH STATION


