

## Pest Management at Codman Yard



Efforts will be taken throughout the [Codman Yard Expansion and Improvements](#) project to maintain the state of the yard and surrounding area. **Pest control is part of the contract, and measures will be put in place to monitor and humanely control pest populations.** During construction, the contractor has developed an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Plan that will result in environmentally sound pest suppression and prevention using a variety of technological and management practices.

*Environmental control strategies will include, but not necessarily be limited to:*



### Monitor and Control

Scheduled monitoring to evaluate the effectiveness of the program and need for additional measures



### Keeping Area Clean

Maintain the areas that they impact, making sure that any trash generated from project is cleaned, and will also implement dust control measures

Structural and procedural modifications to reduce food, water, harborage, and access used by pests



### Mechanical and Chemical

Non-pesticide technologies such as trapping and monitoring devices

Pesticide compounds, formulations, and application methods, if needed, that present the lowest potential hazard to humans, domestic pets, and the environment
