


Signal Upgrades




Orange Line Signals: Increasing capacity, through reducing headways with modernized signals

- ✓ This Week | At Wellington crews continued with the installation of new signal racks, wires, and cables at the temporary signal house. At Sullivan Square, crews tested track circuits at night. Wayside cables were installed at Gainsborough truck pad moving toward Back Bay
- **Lookahead** | Continue with installation of testing equipment and components, with testing at Wellington Yard, Sullivan Square, and Gainsborough truck pad

• **Coolcations** | Test trains will continue to run, and electricians will continue with miscellaneous installations and punch list work




