


Bus Network Redesign Implementation

About the MBTA Advisory Board

- 176 cities and towns that host a T station, or abut one that does
- Assessed \$183m in FY23
- Statutorily created, and mandated to conduct oversight of the MBTA
- Our Chair, Mayor Thomas P. Koch represents us on MBTA BOD





BNRD Questions

 - Does BNRD vote allow staff to implement route changes without municipal consultation until 2027?

BNRD: 400 new bus operators

Today's Gap: 350 bus operators

- 12-month authorizations based on achievements
- Annual updates to BOD and Advisory Board
- Implementation plan tied to the staffing plan, CIP, operating budget realities, fleet and facilities plan, etc.
- Bus management plan to improve bus OTP over 75% target.
- Long-term vision for a larger, cleaner bus fleet.
