

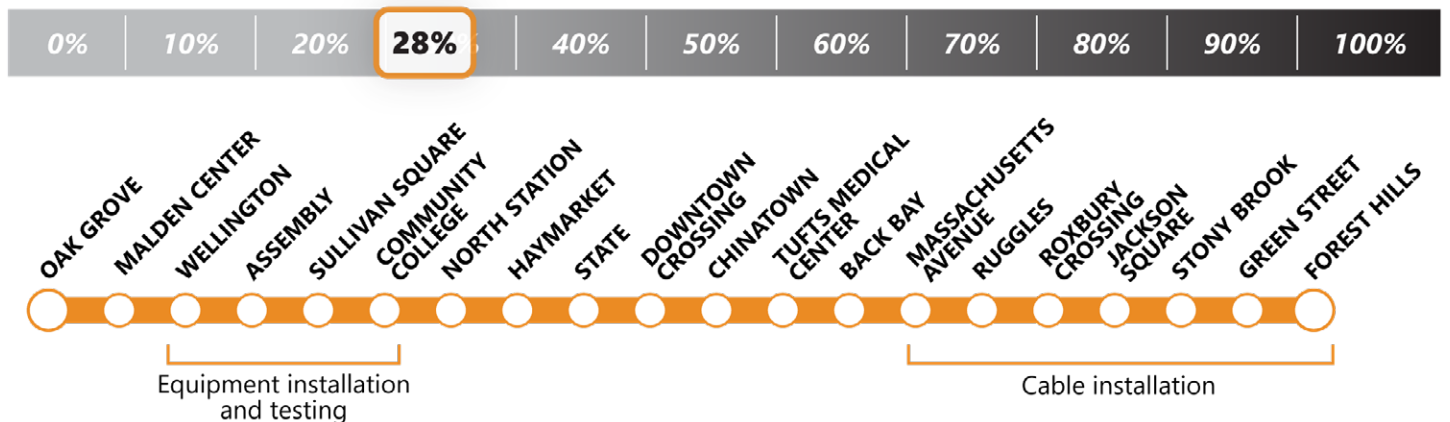
## Week in Review and Lookahead

## Signal Upgrades



**Orange Line Signals:** Increase capacity by reducing headways with modernized signals

- ✓ **This Week** | | At Wellington South crews continued with the installation of new signal racks, wires, and cables. At Wellington North, point-to-point testing was conducted during the day and train detection tests were conducted at night
- **Lookahead** | Crews will continue testing and installation between Wellington and Community College

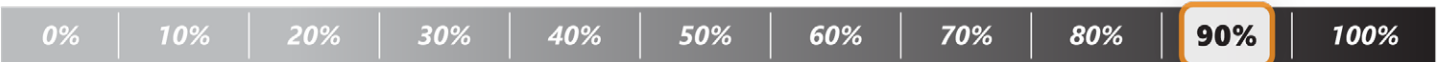
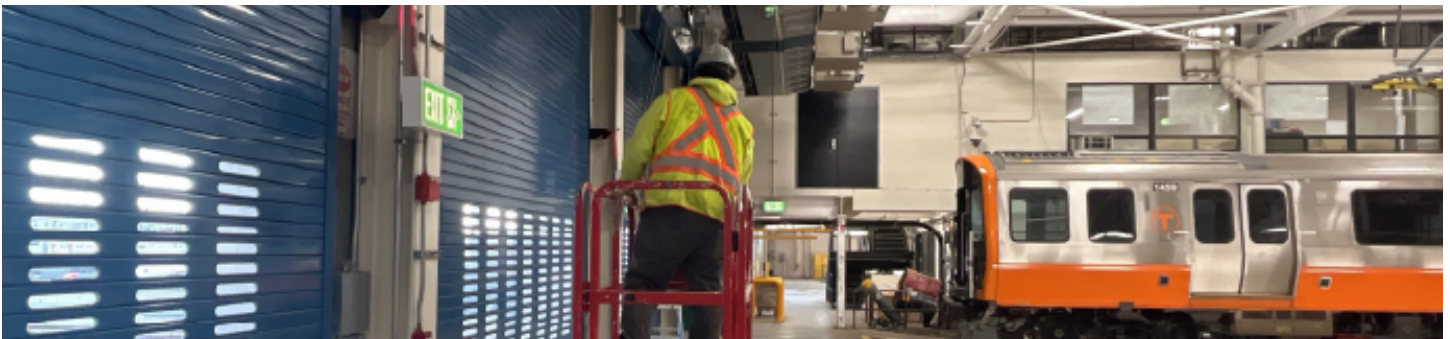


Traction Power & Signals



Wellington Yard: Upgrade Wellington Yard to increase service capacity, replace outdated infrastructure, and enhance safety.

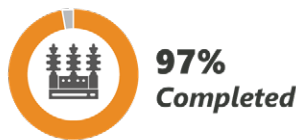

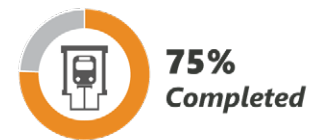

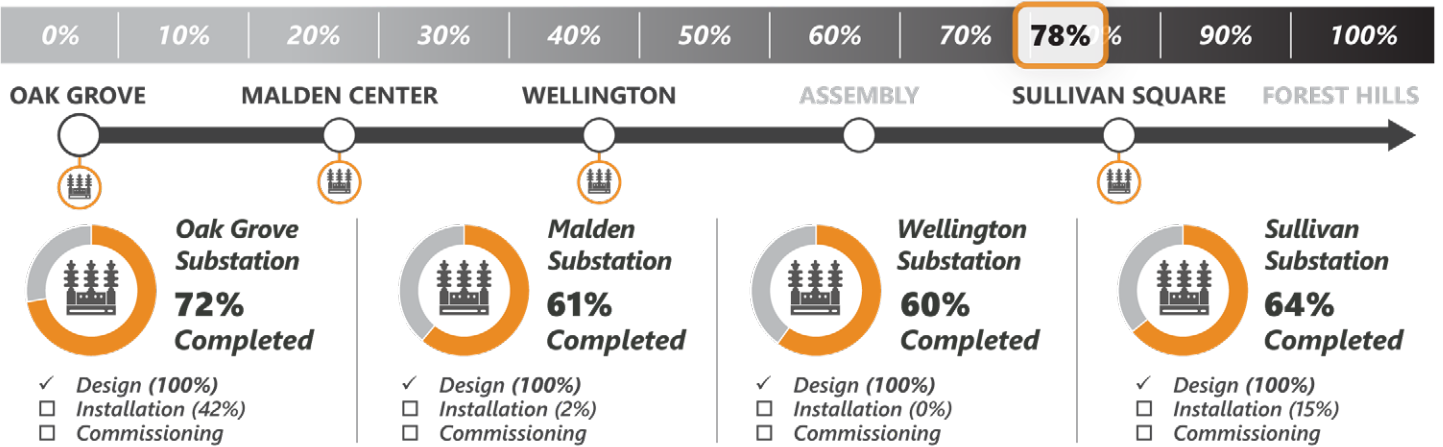


Wellington Maintenance Facility: Modernize the Vehicle Maintenance Facility to improve vehicle maintenance; reducing customer wait times, provide cleaner cars, and deliver safer operations.

- ✓ **This Week** | Crews worked on the restraining rail at track 18 and flushed built up sediment from filtration system at track 20. Electricians tested the fire alarm system and painters touched-up various locations within the car house
- **Lookahead** | Crews will continue working at tracks 18 and 20. Electricians will continue working on the fire alarm system and painters will touch-up miscellaneous locations within the car house
