

Rider's Guide: Red Line Disruption Harvard – JFK/UMass March 4–5 and 25–26, 2023

Free shuttle buses will replace service between Harvard and JFK/UMass the weekends of March 4–5 and 25–26 to allow for testing of the new digital signal system on the Red Line. The new system will result in faster and more reliable service.

Shuttles will also stop at Haymarket and State, but will not service Park Street.



All shuttles are accessible and equipped with a ramp or lift. Accessible van shuttles are available for any customer with a disability who prefers not to use a shuttle bus. Please see station personnel or use a station call box to request an accessible van.
