


Week in Review and Lookahead Friday, April 7, 2023

Work will continue April 18 – 20, from 8:45 PM to the end of service, when shuttle buses replace **Red Line service** from Park Street to JFK/UMass for rail and tie replacement.

- **Lookahead** | Crews will continue with excavating stockpiled material, clearing trees and vegetation on MBTA property, and surveying to establish elevations for the new storage tracks
