The Columbus Avenue Bus Lanes Project aims to improve transit times along some of our busiest bus routes. Phase 2 is in the concept development stage, and will include improvements to bus stops and shelters along Columbus Avenue and Tremont Street.

Since the last round of outreach, the project team has developed a preliminary concept design of the corridor. This preliminary design will be shared for your feedback at a series of meetings in May. The MBTA and City of Boston will provide an overview of the project, describe the concept and the key tradeoffs that were considered, and highlight opportunities for the public to provide feedback on specific elements of the design prior to moving into design engineering.
