
## **Codman Yard Expansion and Improvements**



<u>Codman Yard Expansion and Improvements:</u> Upgrade the yard to increase service capacity, replace outdated infrastructure, and enhance safety

- ✓ This Week | Crews installed precast utility vaults, reinforcing steel and concrete for the traction power ductbanks to provide a protected pathway for underground electrical conduit from the substation to the electrified third rail
- **Lookahead** | Crews will continue to excavate trenches for installation of traction power ductbanks and install utility vaults under the new train storage tracks

## **Cabot Yard and Maintenance Facility Updates**



<u>Cabot Yard:</u> Upgrade Cabot Yard to increase service capacity, replace outdated infrastructure, and enhance safety.

- ✓ This Week | The engineer of record continued developing as-builts (site drawings) for the existing ductbanks based on previous test pit inspections
- **Lookahead** | The engineer of record will continue developing drawings, coordinating locations of existing and proposed traction power ductbanks for use by the contractor during installation of the new infrastructure
