- ✓ This Week | Crews excavated, formed, and prepared for placement of traction power duct banks. Crews also worked on plumbing in the MBTA trailers, screened soils for offsite disposal, and prepared for weekend work to upgrade the transformer
- **Lookahead** | Crews will continue to excavate trenches for installation of traction power duct banks, install utility vaults under the new train storage tracks, and screen and haul soil offsite
