## **Week in Review and Lookahead**Friday, July 28, 2023

Today, crews are finalizing work on the **B Branch Track Upgrades** project. Through this project we have replaced over 2,800 feet of track, upgraded two intersections, and leveraged the opportunity to complete other work around the B Branch. This project will result in safer, more reliable service for Green Line riders. Service will return on time Saturday, July 29.

From Saturday, July 29 through Wednesday, August 9, **Green Line** service will be suspended between North Station and Government Center to allow a private developer to work on Government Center Garage demolition.
