 Finding 3: Cleared Tufts Curve Speed Restriction last month shortly after a successful walk through with the FTA – FTA Closed on July 17, 2023


#### **Special Directive 22-06 OCC**

#### **Track Access Capacity**


Continue to monitor work crew capacity and ROW safety

- Revised initial ROW eight-hour training module reviewed and approved – to be put into effect this month





#### MBTA has finalized and will publish an updated Rulebook for Operations Employees


- Major accomplishment and a huge amount of work to update

- Available electronically and in hard copy for Operations employees later this month






- F9: Restored Green Line Work Train to Working Order CAP CLOSED




