MBTA Finding Closure Progress

Four Special Directive 22-06 OCC Findings closed:

- Finding 1: Required weekly OCC passenger service schedules for each rail line and daily "as performed" schedules.
- Finding 2: Required MBTA to submit documentation confirming OCC staff have sufficient time off to recover between shifts.
- Finding 3: Required the MBTA to submit documentation confirming that, for each shift, OCC supervisors are not scheduled to perform both supervisory and dispatcher roles.
- Finding 4: (CAP 4) MBTA requires its OCC personnel to work in a fatigued state as a pattern and practice; closure requested Aug. 4, 2023.

FTA relaxed some of the IAL reporting requirements MBTA has requested closure of 22-4 Finding 1 (CAP 1)






SD 22-4: Track Maintenance & PPE
