The Ashmont Branch of the Red Line features some of the oldest tracks in the system. In the upcoming surge, our crews will revitalize the rail infrastructure—encompassing replacing rail, ties, and ballast between JFK/UMass and Ashmont, bringing this area closer to a state of good repair and ultimately enhancing passenger travel times by eliminating 28-speed restrictions.

We will also actively seek opportunities to enhance the rider experience by focusing on station improvements, vegetation removal, and accessibility enhancements. Given that many riders on the Mattapan Line transfer to the Red Line at Ashmont, conducting trackwork concurrently on both lines will further enhance reliability and service, all while minimizing disruption to riders.
