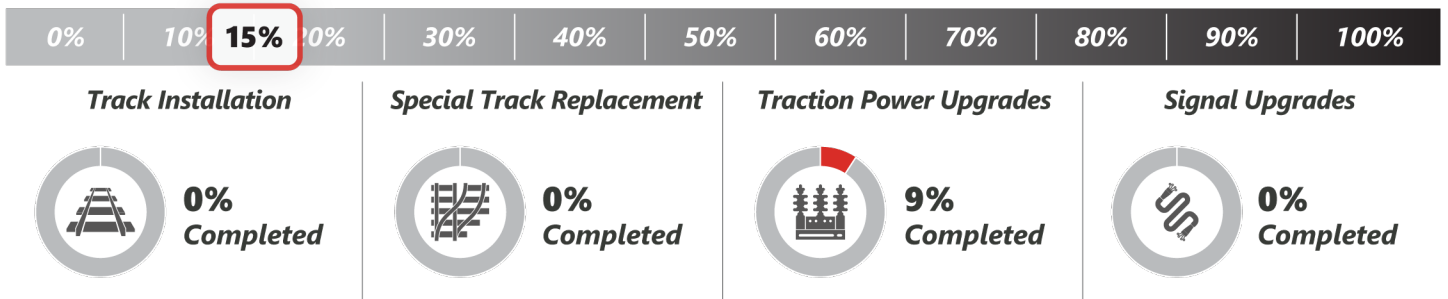

- **Lookahead** | Signal components and materials will be delivered, installed, and tested during the upcoming weekend diversions on the Red Line

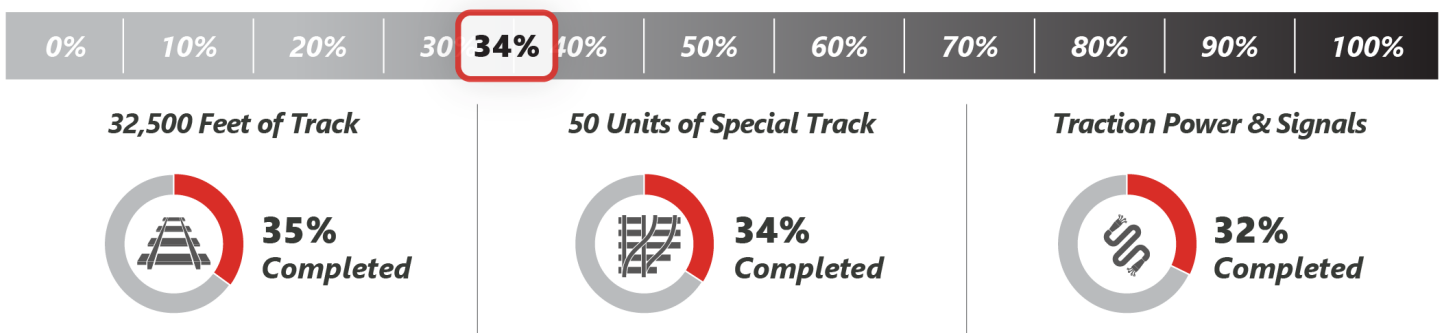
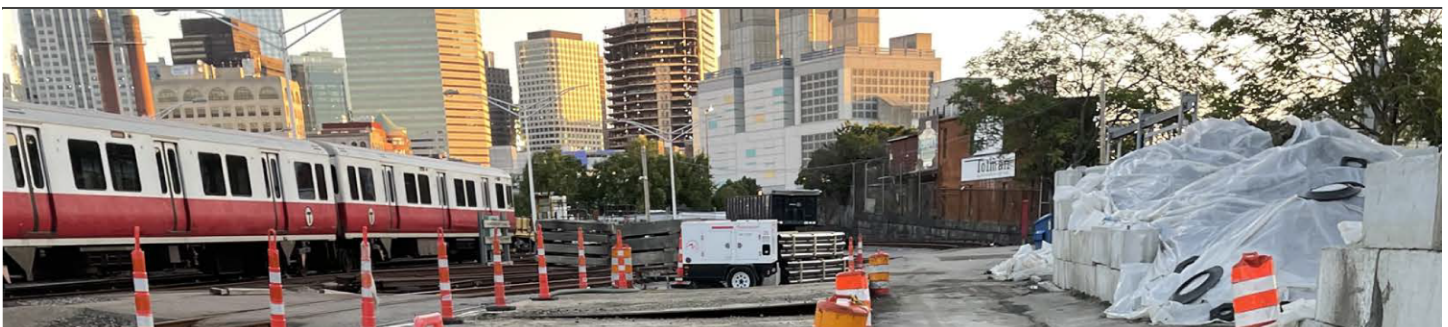
# Codman Yard Expansion and Improvements
