


Week in Review and Lookahead Friday, October 6, 2023

This week, crews worked to upgrade Codman and Cabot Yards, and preparations continued for the upcoming surge on the Ashmont branch of the Red Line and the Mattapan Line. Shuttle buses will replace Red Line service between Broadway and Ashmont & Broadway and North Quincy this weekend, October 7 - 8, to allow for bridge work, tunnel inspections, and station maintenance. Signal Upgrades: Increase safety and reliability with modernized signals


- This Week | Last weekend, crews installed a new signal bungalow at Columbia Junction. There was no work scheduled during the week
- **Lookahead** | Signal components and materials will be delivered, installed, and tested during the upcoming weekend diversions on the Red Line

- Lookahead | Crews will continue installing duct banks and boring for the new utility bridge pilings
