Regular Green Line service has resumed after Union Branch and Government Center Garage related service disruptions, and progress continues on the Symphony Station Accessibility Improvements as part of the Green Line Transformation (GLT) program.

At <u>Symphony Station</u>, crews continued work on a 10" steam line and Eversource duct bank excavation near Symphony Hall. Contractors also removed two light poles and installed three temporary LED lights at Massachusetts Ave & Huntington Ave. Work on the Eversource duct bank and steam line relocation will continue over the coming weeks.
