# **GLT Improvements Continue Across the Green Line**

### • Symphony Station Accessibility Improvements

Work to relocate utilities around Symphony Station in advance of accessibility upgrades. At <a href="Symphony Station">Symphony Station</a>, ongoing work on excavation for Eversource duct bank and a 10" steam line near Symphony Hall will continue in the coming weeks.
