OLT Improvements Continue Across the Orange Line

• Wellington Maintenance Facility

Modernizing the <u>Vehicle Maintenance Facility</u> will reduce downtime and customer wait times, provide cleaner trains, and deliver safer operations. In the maintenance facility, crews are applying sealer coatings at tracks 12 and 13. Going forward, crews will continue working on track 12 and 13 drains, completing fire alarm installation, and closing out punch list items.

• Orange Line Traction Power Substation Upgrades

Upgrades to the <u>Traction Power Substations</u> will modernize the third rail power supply to reduce the risk of service disruptions, as well as develop a power system capable of supporting additional Orange Line service. At Sullivan, crews are working on feeders to the passenger station and miscellaneous lighting and conduits. Looking ahead, crews will continue performing cable connections, installing electrical connections, and testing mobile substation at Sullivan station.
