Safety Updates to Tools & Equipment

- Safety and Operations Divisions continue to work closely together to improve safety.
- Individuals work in very challenging environments, and we want to help ensure they have the tools and equipment that will keep them safe.
- Currently working to further enhance safety by identifying and procuring new and improved safety tools and equipment.
- Tools include insulated hand tools and cap protectors.








Safety Performance Indicators Trend Analysis

Bus


- Significant improvement in Total Bus Injuries and Rate of Bus Injuries (per 1 million revenue miles) between October 2022 and October 2023, decreasing total number of injuries from 43 to 31 and rate of injuries from 23.40 to 17.64
- There were <u>15</u> Total Bus Safety Events in October
- The on-target YTD Total Number of Bus Safety Events at this point was 81.67, our YTD total is 104 (106% of annual target)





Safety Performance Indicators Trend Analysis Heavy Rail

- In October, the MBTA averaged 52,253 revenue miles per major mechanical failure on the heavy rail, exceeding the performance target by a rate of 8,753 miles
- The updated CY2023 Heavy Rail System Reliability Average is 61,925 revenue miles per major mechanical failure, exceeding the performance target by a rate of 17,425 revenue miles
- There was only 1 Total Heavy Rail Safety Event in October
- The on-target YTD Total Number of Heavy Rail Safety Events at this point was 20, our YTD total is 22 (92% of annual target)



2023 MBTA Agents of Safety Awards



- Agents of Safety Awards are held annually to honor MBTA's safety employees for their outstanding performance.
- Award program acknowledges employees who have demonstrated high levels of safety excellence in their job performance or have provided valuable safety input that has affected a positive change.
- This year, awards were given to 36 individuals at a ceremony held on Wednesday, December 6.
