Project Purpose:

- The purpose of this project is to construct an Interim Station in Lynn that will restore service while the design and construction of the permanent station takes place

Project Benefits:

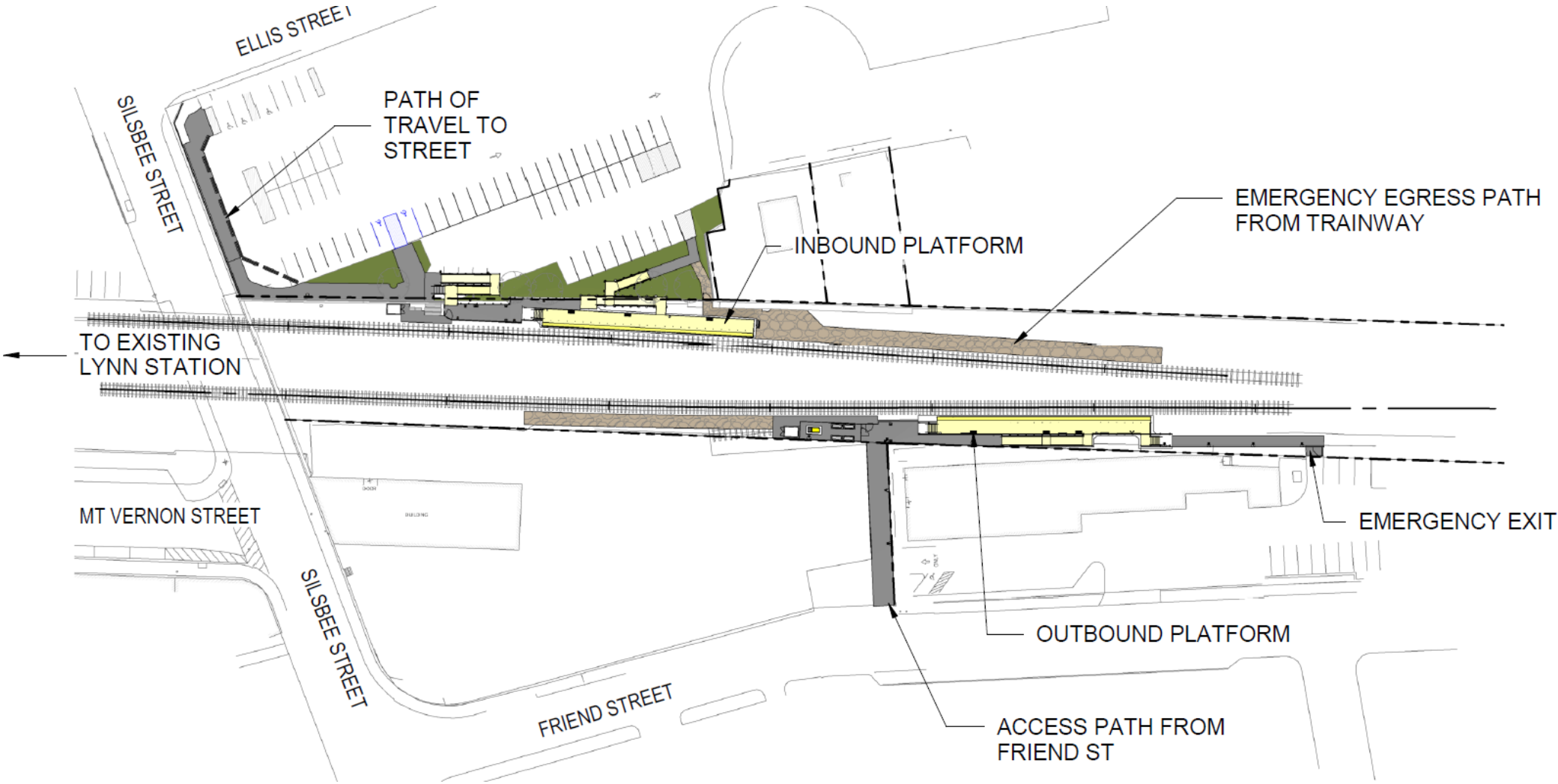
- Maintain Commuter Rail service for the Lynn community while the full reconstruction project at Lynn Station is ongoing

Interim Station Construction will be performed by Keolis:

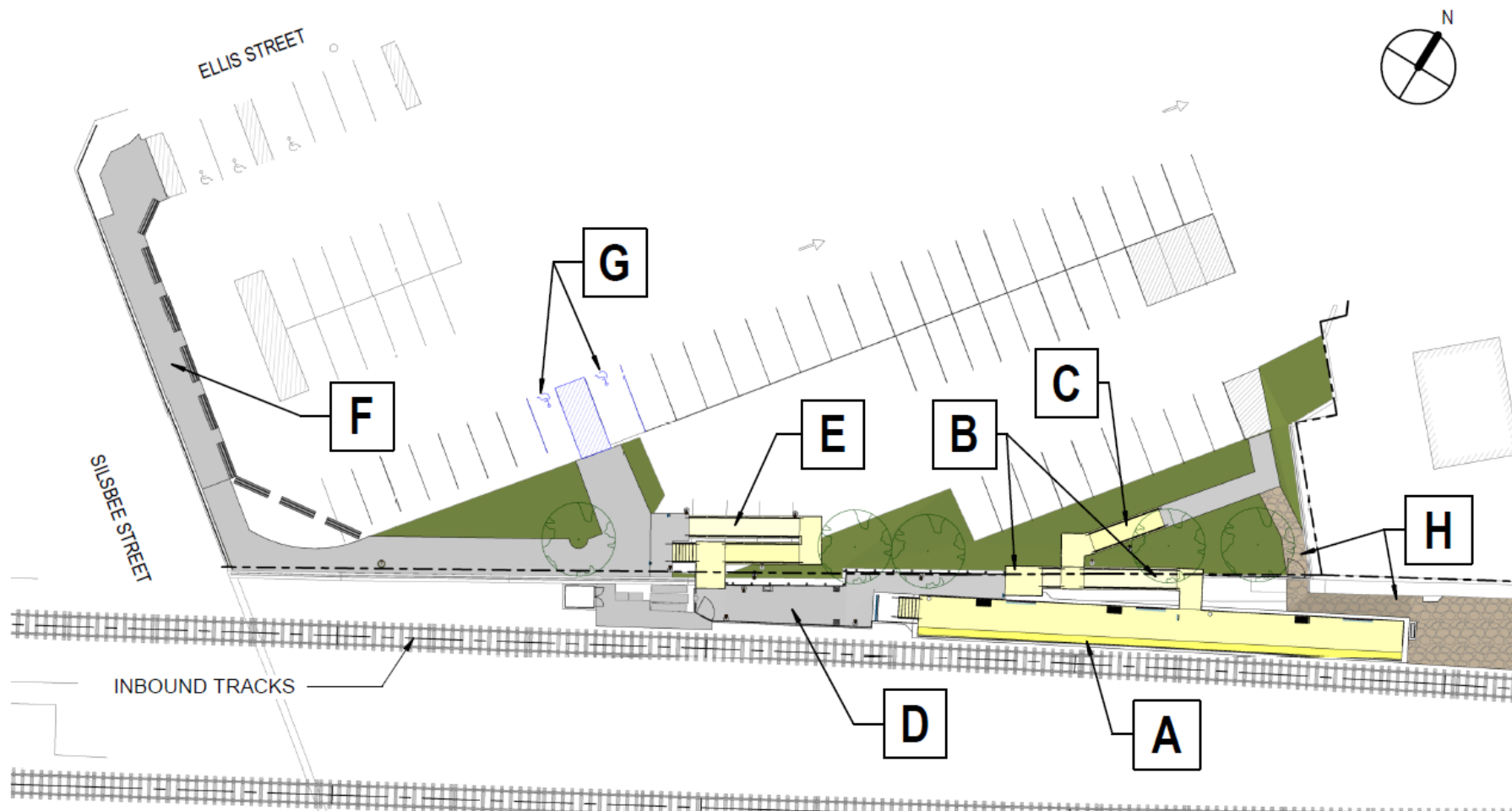
- Anticipated Construction Start: Summer 2023

Interim Station: Inbound Platform Site Plan

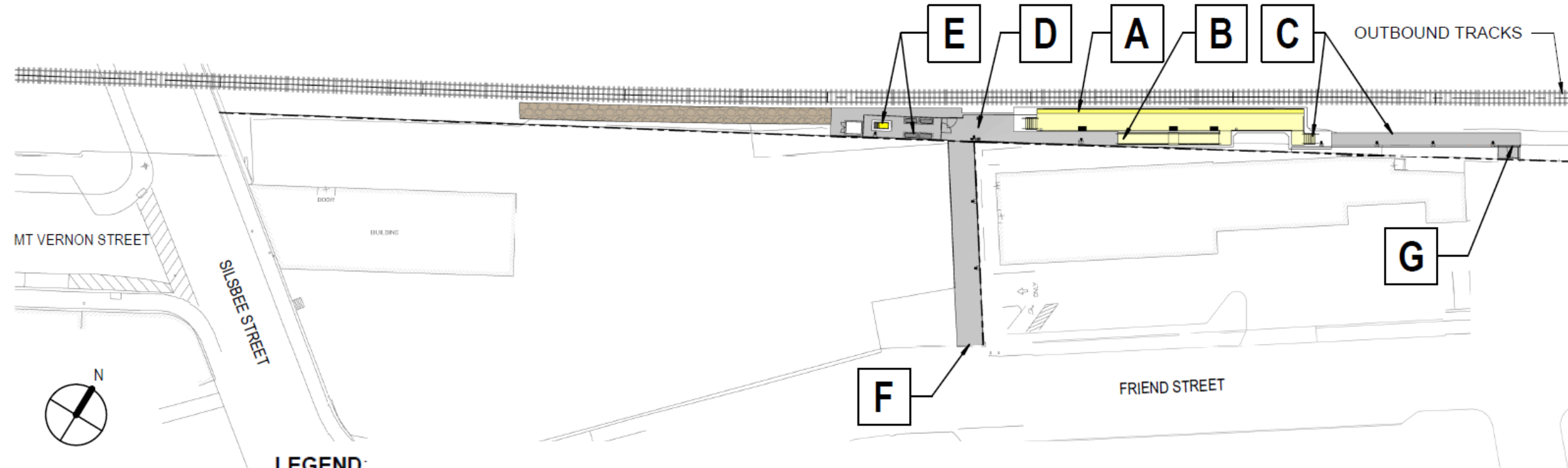

- G. EMERGENCY EGRESS GATE IN FENCE



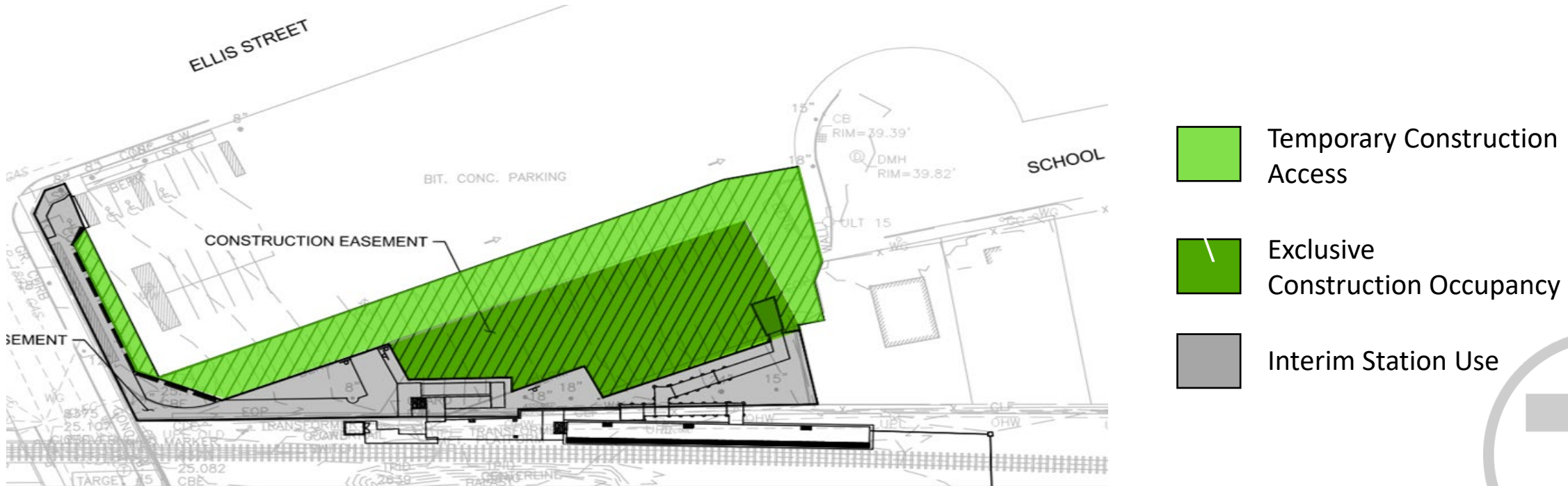
Construction Schedule

Anticipated Interim Station Opening	March 2024



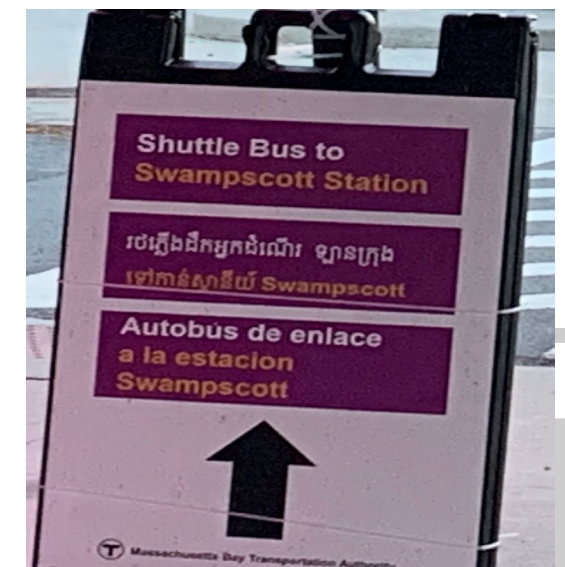
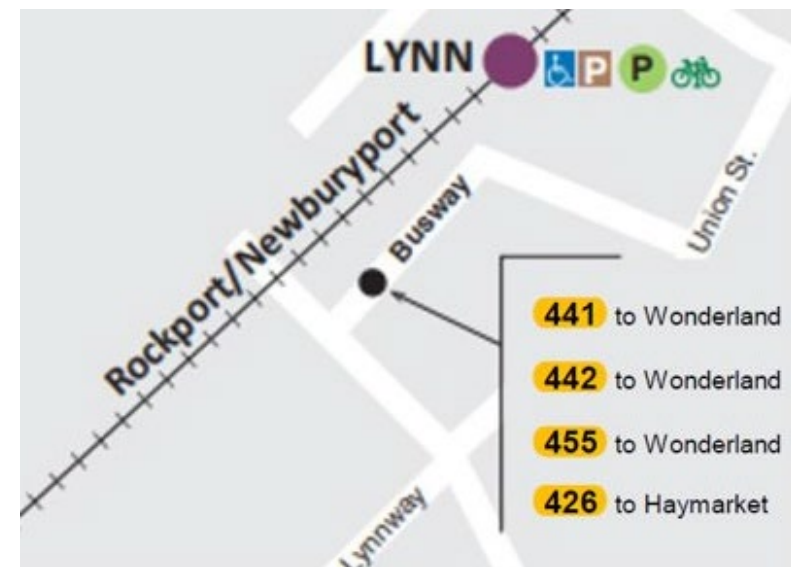
What to Expect During Construction

- Neighbors can expect noise from construction activity, including heavy equipment and machinery
- Work will primarily take place during the day, Monday – Friday, 7am – 5pm
- Construction advisories will be distributed ahead of any scheduled night or weekend work, if necessary



Service Alternatives

- **Shuttle busing** between Lynn and Swampscott Station will continue through the opening of the interim station construction.
 - From the North: Swampscott Station to the 455
 - From Boston: Blue Line at Wonderland Station to the 441, 442, or 455
 - From Chelsea: 117 from Bellingham Square to Wonderland Station to the 441, 442, or 455
 - 426 Express Service between Lynn Central Square and Haymarket
- **Lynn Ferry** will provide service between Blossom Street Pier and Long Wharf
