



Marketing & Communications Outreach


The MBTA is launching a comprehensive marketing strategy to reach income-eligible individuals who would benefit from the newly expanded MBTA reduced fare program. The tactical approach will utilize MBTA assets and leverage collaboration with community and government agencies working with the eligible individuals.



GOAL: To reach eligible individuals, drive applications, facilitate enrollment, and ultimately increase ridership

TARGET AUDIENCE: Massachusetts residents, between 18 and 64, who participate in accepted state or federal benefit programs and are not currently covered by other existing MBTA-reduced-fare programs may be eligible.

Program Overview

As approved by the Board in March, the MBTA is expanding reduced fares to income-eligible riders.

- <u>Eligibility</u>: The program is designed to enroll riders under 200% of the federal poverty level (FPL). Riders will prove eligibility via enrollment in other aid programs with cutoffs at or below 200% FPL and will be enrolled for 1 year.
- <u>Application</u>: Riders will apply primarily via an online application. The application uses API connections to Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV) and Health & Human Services (HHS) data to confirm identity and eligibility. Manual uploads and in-person support are available for riders whose needs are not met by the online and automatic application process.
- <u>Partners</u>: The MBTA has contracted with ABCD & the MASSCAP network to provide in-person and in-community
 program support and Omicron Technology Solutions to provide back-office application review services.
- <u>Fare Media</u>: Approved riders will be mailed a CharlieCard that will allow them to purchase half-priced tickets and passes (using faregates, fareboxes and fare vending machines) or enroll in half-priced contactless payments.
- <u>Modes</u>: The proposed program will apply to fares on all modes. As part of this expansion of reduced fares, on the RIDE, income-eligible riders and seniors will be eligible for half fares on Standard & Premium trips.
