


MBTA Mission, Vision, Goals, and Values

FY24 Accomplishments by Strategic Goal

SAFETY

- Upgraded 246 commuter rail grade crossings
- Re-organized Safety division and increased staffing

SERVICE & ECONOMIC VIABILITY

- Launched contactless payments
- Developed free standing mini high program to improve commuter rail accessibility
- Increased weekday ridership compared to previous year

MODERNIZATION & STATE OF GOOD REPAIR

- Eliminated 130+ speed restrictions (FY24)
- Reopened Lynn,
 Ashland, and South
 Attleboro Stations

- Added 3 new ferry services
- Launched permanent commuter rail service to Foxboro

Addressing threats to the system, focused on resilience




