Increased ridership by 25% on the Commuter Rail since July 2023.



Implementing a Training Relief Program to schedule regular professional development for bus operators.



Completion of accessibility upgrades on the Green Line D Branch, making four stations fully accessible.



Funding equitable transit access through new Income-Eligible Reduced Fares Program.
