MBTA's South Coast Rail (SCR) will restore Commuter Rail service to southeastern MA in spring 2025. Until that time, the MBTA is testing trains to meet federally mandated safety requirements. Trains will reach the approved maximum speed of 79 mph in many areas shown on the map.

We are alerting Delivery and Commercial Drivers to best practices in the area. Trains and grade crossings have not been in active use for nearly 65 years. You may not be aware of the new commuter rail service. Don't be a risk taker - you can avoid truck or van tragedies by knowing the facts.

Consider these facts:

- Know your route and be aware of where railroad crossings are
- Always expect a train and know that trains can run at any time, on any track in either direction
