Recent Incidents and Corrective Actions Safety Risk Management: Short Train Operation

- SRM workshop discussions first began on short train operation in 2023 in relation to Orange Line trains
 - Due to issues with the then existing fleet, we needed to rapidly retire the fleet and there was concern regarding having enough trains to operate
 - New train delivery kept up with the needs and this process was shelved
- In 2024, Short Train Operation was resurrected, but on the Red Line.
- Using hazards and mitigations from the initial SRM workshop discussions in 2023, Red Line short train operation was able to be quickly field tested
- Field verification activities occur when short trains are in operation

Safety Risk Management: Single Track Operation

- A series of SRM workshops were hosted between May 2024 and January 2025 to review Single Track Operation risks and hazards
- The feasibility of Single Track Operation was tested with representation from Operations, Transit Rail Safety, and Systemwide Accessibility
- Supplemental SRM workshops will continue to manage safety risk as this operation evolves
- Single Track Operation offers continuous service when operation on both tracks is unattainable due to
 - Routine or construction work on one track
 - Maintenance hazards that need mitigation on one track
- Single Track Operation may or may not be supplemented with shuttle buses
