Boston World Cup 2026 Fact Sheet

Activities	Current Actions
Matches	6 of the 7 games are weekdays, with 1 Quarter Final Match all at Boston Stadium
Match Times	FIFA currently estimates 12p.m., 4p.m., 6p.m., or 9p.m. games; Discussing late game impacts to service with FIFA
General Attendance	Stadium seats 62,000 with ~ 35,000 general purpose seats
Transit Access	MBTA has committed to moving 20,000 passengers per game in and out of Foxboro Station on CR
Match Coordination	On-going coordination planning with the other 11 US Host Cities, 2 from Canada, and 3 from Mexico – fans move with teams
Regional Coordination	Coordinating with our RTA partners, RIPTA, and Amtrak, as well as MassDOT and RIDOT on bus/train access, bus hubs
Fan Festival	Fan Festival is planned for downtown Boston, spanning the duration of the World Cup; Times and location(s) pending

The MBTA is working hard to minimize service impacts to its customers in surrounding regions




Economic Benefits to region are significant. Legacy benefits as well.

MBTA Efforts To Date

Committee Participation

With local Boston26 and regional/national efforts

Safety and Security:



- Blackout construction period to promote safety & service reliability
- Developing a Safety and Security Plan with MassDOT/PD – Highest priority

Operations – Bus/Ferry/Subway:



- Identified budget for additional service hours during the WC games – including MA250, Tall Ships, Harborfest, and July 4th

Operations – Commuter Rail:



- Service planning for 20K passengers to Foxboro Station

Stations:



- Funding Secured for ADA accessible station at Foxboro
- Airport Station updates

Wayfinding:



- Communication needs in several languages
- Enhanced wayfinding at stations – Legacy improvements

Ticketing:



- Special Event ticket cost, availability
- Access to service – linking apps, unbanked
- Coordinating with Keolis and experience in Qatar/Paris

Internal Committees:



- Created 14 internal committees for coordination
- Establishing an internal monthly progress update in TSTOP
