- **New bus boarding platforms** with accessibility improvements, including a raised boarding platform, real-time information, and enhanced signage
- **Dedicated bi-directional busway**, that will make way for future Silver Line 3 (SL3) service between Chelsea and Sullivan Square
- **Separated bike lanes**
- **Pedestrian safety** improvements
