



Milton Sloped Walkway Project Adams Street – Milton, MA

Project Overview

The MBTA is constructing a new ADA-compliant sloped walkway at Milton Station to improve accessibility and provide safer access from Adams Street.

Location

The project is located along Adams Street in Milton, MA, adjacent to the Neponset Trail and Milton Station.

What This Project Includes

- Removal of existing pavement and concrete curb
- Construction adding a sloped concrete walkway.
- Installation of granite curb and bituminous concrete
- Upgrades to retaining walls
- Lighting and security camera system installation
- Handrailing installation
- Station signage, trail blazing signage as well as Lollipop sign installation
- Temporary fencing and site work
- Landscaping improvements

Construction Information

- The station will remain open during construction.
- Traffic coordination will be in place to manage both vehicle and pedestrian access.
- Some limited staging and storage areas will be used within the work zone.
- Start date Early April 2026 End date August 2026
