## **MBTA Boston Landing Station – May 22, 2017**

Boston Landing Station officially added to the Framingham / Worcester Line effective May 22<sup>nd</sup>

Schedule Information

 Six AM Peak inbound stops and six PM Peak outbound stops will occur Monday through Friday

Fare information

- Zone 1A fare - \$2.25/one-way fare, \$84.50/monthly pass

Capital delivery information

- Ground breaking held on May 12, 2015 and construction began in October 2015
- Design and construction of the station was paid for by New Balance, who will also pay for all maintenance costs of the station for the first ten years of its service

Transit-Oriented Development The New Balance Development Group intends to open 650,000 square feet of office space, 275 residential housing units, 80,000 square feet of restaurant/retail space, 140,000 square feet for a 175-room hotel, and new athletic facilities adjacent to Boston Landing Station
