

MBTA Contract No. G70CN02: On-Call Commuter Rail Construction Services for Right-of-Way Improvements

February 5, 2018



OVERVIEW

 Today's board action will provide for on-call construction services to support the urgent and routine right-of-way repair and reconstruction needs of the Authority across the Commuter Rail system.

 The Authority seeks Board approval to execute this contract in order to enhance customer safety and on-time performance.





Keolis Responsibilities and MBTA Capital Construction Projects

- This Commuter Rail On-Call Contract does not relieve Keolis of any contractual obligations under their Operating Agreement.
- This construction contract will address capital maintenance projects and capital improvement projects that fall outside of Keolis' routine maintenance scope.
- Once the condition of an asset can no longer be addressed through routine maintenance it becomes a capital maintenance project which is handled through an MBTA capital construction project.



Construction Scope

- Provide construction-related services on an on-call basis to support state of good repair/reconstruction needs of the Authority.
 - Work primarily consists of right-of-way repair and reconstruction work, including drainage, wall, concrete, and platform repairs.
 - Work is anticipated to be performed throughout the MBTA service area in Massachusetts.
- Work will be assigned on a project by project basis, as directed by the Authority, and will utilize bid items and contractor unit prices.







Construction Advertisement and Bid Process

- Project was advertised on December 6, 2017
- Engineer's Estimate was \$19,898,806
- Bid Opening was on January 16, 2018
- Seven (7) Bids were received
