OVERVIEW


The purpose of this presentation is to update the Fiscal and Management Control Board regarding the current status of ongoing Capital Improvements on the Fairmont Line Corridor, including:

- Completion of the new Blue Hill Avenue Station and start of service in February, 2019
- Commencement of Positive Train Control (PTC) Extended Revenue Service Demonstration (RSD) on December 29, 2018
- Maintenance of Right-of-Way (R.O.W.) and infrastructure and improvements



Fairmount Line Corridor

- The Fairmount Line Corridor is approximately 9.2 miles long and runs wholly within the City of Boston
- The line runs from Readville Station in Hyde Park to South Station in the north/south direction and includes seven (7) existing stations
- The entire line is double track
- Approximately 65 trains/day run on the line: 40 commuter trains serve the stations along line; 25 trains go to the storage yard
- CSX also operates on the line






Blue Hill Avenue Station

Construction NTP: Feb. 2017
Planned Opening: Feb. 2019
Construction Contract Value: \$16.97 M
Constr. Expenditures to Date: \$12.9 M
Construction Percent Complete: 98%
Estimated Project Budged: \$22.0 M



Project Scope

- Design and construct a 768
 foot long high level center
 island commuter rail platform
 between Cummins Highway
 and Blue Hill Avenue.
- Included in the design are elevated walkway structures, steel canopies, signage, bench/windscreens, lighting, security and communication systems, track realignment and resurfacing

Project Benefits

- Provide commuter rail service to the Mattapan neighborhood
- Potential destination to Mattapan Square businesses



Positive Train Control Implementation

- Successful line testing and end to end runs: Completed December 2018
- Successful Interoperability testing with Amtrak: Completed December 2018
- Extended RSD Authorized by FRA: Started December 29, 2018

- Asphalt, traffic markings and TMP implementation






Railroad Operations


